

What is Peninsula Community Health Services?

Peninsula Community Health Services (PCHS) is a nonprofit Community Health Center that exemplifies a culture of community service.



Peninsula Community Health Services was founded in 1987 as a community clinic in downtown Bremerton and became a federally qualified health center (FQHC) in 1993. PCHS includes primary medical, dental, behavioral health counseling, substance use treatment, pharmacy services, and health education and promotion activities for all stages of life.

Services are provided to all patients regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay. PCHS patients may qualify for a sliding fee discount based on their household income and family size. PCHS delivers a comprehensive and integrated approach to health care services and has many sites accredited as a Patient-Centered Medical and Dental Home by the Accreditation for Ambulatory Health Care (AAHHC).

Behavioral Health

PCHS provides behavioral health (BH) services as an integrated part of our primary care program. We offer:

- Care coordination with primary care providers
- Depression counseling
- Anxiety counseling
- Medication assisted treatment for addiction
- Healthy lifestyle counseling



Pharmacy

PCHS provides our patients pharmacy services at our Belfair, Port Orchard, Poulsbo, Sixth Street, and Clare Avenue clinics. Each prescription comes through PCHS pharmacies gets a thorough check for drug and disease interactions, dosing safety, and therapy length. We offer:

- 340B program prescription discounts
- 90-day supplies to lower overall costs
- Prescription assistance programs
- Healthy lifestyle counseling
- Drive through pharmacies

Medical

Our Almira, Belfair, Franklin, Kingston, Poulsbo, Port Orchard, Silverdale, Sixth Street, and Clare Avenue medical clinics provide comprehensive, primary medical services for both children and adults that emphasize a holistic, patient-centered approach to medical care. We offer:

- Routine physicals, minor surgery, illness, and injury treatment
- Immunizations & flu shots
- Chronic disease care
- Breast, cervical, & colon cancer screenings



Mobile

PCHS has several mobile clinics: Medical, Dental, Quick Response Team (QRT), & Behavioral Health. PCHS clinics extend access to our patients with challenges around scheduling, transportation, or changing work schedules.

Our Medical Mobile Clinic Offers:

- Screening, prevention, & routine check-ups
- Acute and chronic illness treatment
- Simple procedures and injury care

Our Behavioral Health and QRT Mobile Clinics Offer:

- Counseling & crisis intervention
- Coping skills & stress management
- Substance use support



Dental

Our dental clinics help to keep smiles healthy from infancy through adulthood. We offer:

- Preventative care
- Oral examination
- Oral hygiene
- Digital x-rays
- Emergency care
- Dental education & information



School-Based Care

PCHS has partnered with the Bremerton, Central Kitsap, North Kitsap, and North Mason school districts to provide students and their families access to medical and behavioral health services at Mountain View, Esquire Hills, Fairview, and on the North Mason School District campus. We offer:
