By having health care accessible at the schools:

- Students benefit because they don't have to travel to find a provider or counselor.
- The child's caregiver benefits because they don't have to take a day off work or spend time waiting to be seen at a clinic.
- Schools benefit because students spend more time in the classroom

- Evaluation and treatment of common health problems
- Sports physicals
- Preventative health care
- Tobacco/vaping cessation counseling
- Social health care
- Suicide screening
- Emotional health care
- No wait times
- Caregivers can accompany childrer
- Caregivers can sign a consent form for children to be seen without requiring them to be present
- A visit summary can be electronically sent to the caregiver after patient's visit is completed
- Referrals to other health care providers car be arranged as needed
- Patients can be seen without leaving school, providing more time in the classroom
- Caregivers do not have to leave work/home, cutting down time traveling to appointments
